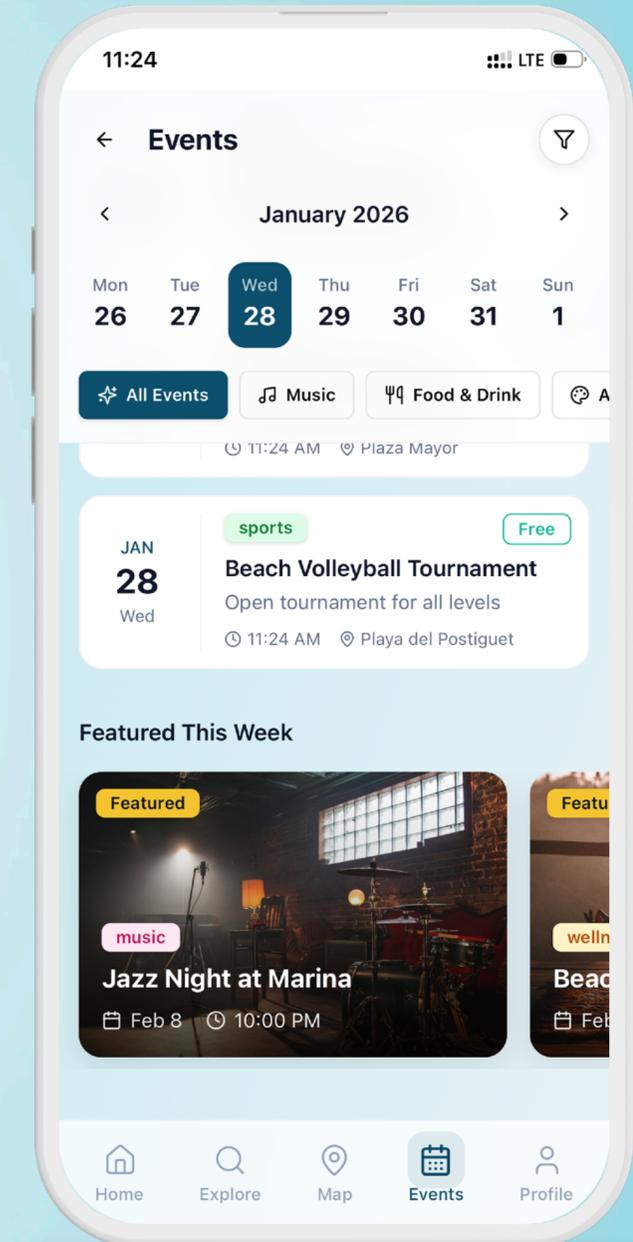
# costera mission

When people can easily discover, book, and engage with what's around them, the whole region becomes stronger, more sustainable, and more human.



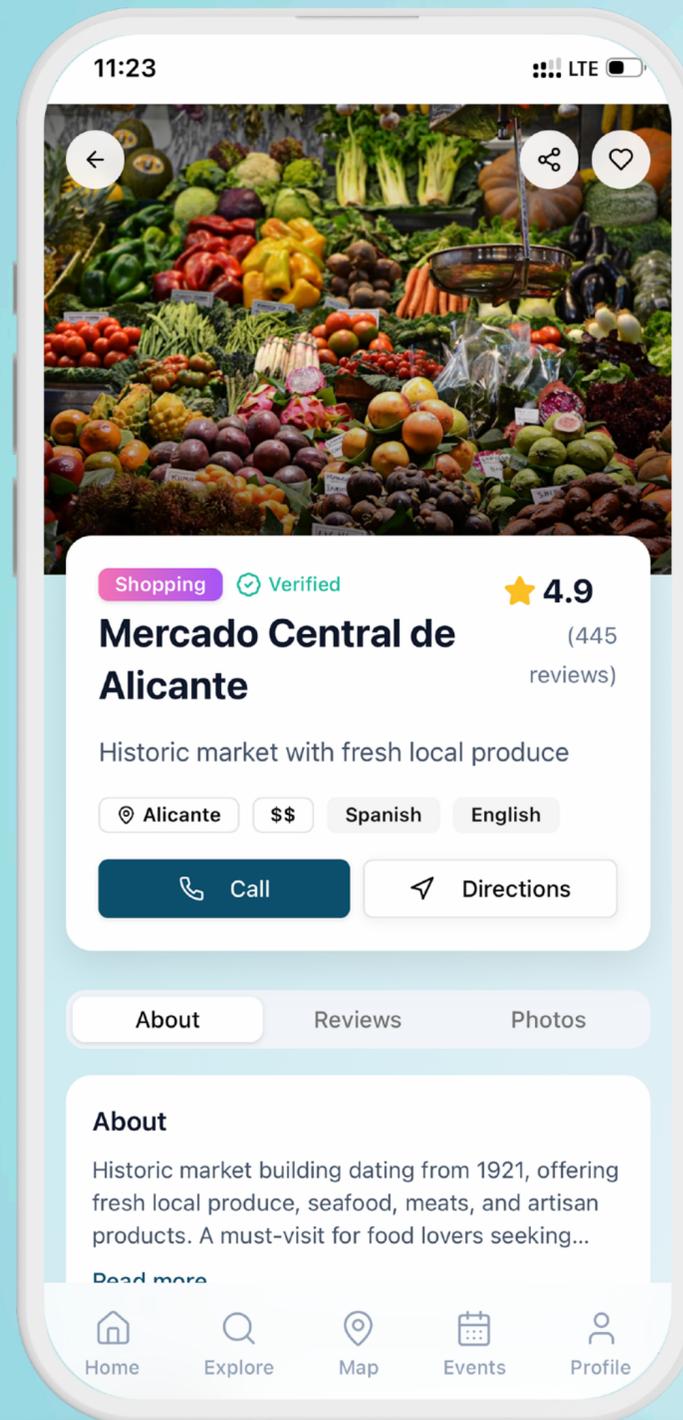
## Costa Blanca has everything — except one way to connect it all...

Costa Blanca is one of Europe's most desirable regions, yet:

- Local services live in Facebook groups
- Attractions are scattered across dozens of sites
- Small businesses are invisible to tourists
- Towns operate in silos
- New residents feel lost

**The result: a fragmented economy where people, money and opportunity fail to connect.**





## costera changes the unit economics

- The place people go first

# Business Model

## B2C — free access

Locals and tourists use Costera for:

- discovery
- bookings
- concierge
- community



## Regional Advertising

Hyper—targeted, high—intent placements:

- “Near you now”
- “Popular with visitors”
- “Recommended this week”



# Business Model

## B2B – Tiered Business Subscriptions

Local businesses pay a monthly fee based on annual revenue and category, not flat pricing.

Business Type	Annual Revenue	Monthly Fee
Solo services (guides, therapists, tutors)	< €50k	€19–29
Small businesses (cafés, rentals, studios)	€50k–250k	€49–99
High-volume operators (tours, marinas, agencies)	€250k+	€149–399

What they get:

- Visibility in search and maps
- Bookings and messaging
- Customer reviews
- Analytics and insights
- Direct access to tourists



# Business Model

## Public Sector and Municipal Subscriptions

Town halls, tourism boards and regional governments pay for:

- Event distribution
- Tourist info
- Emergency and service alerts
- Data and analytics



# Business Model

## Partnerships and Regional Deals

Costera becomes the channel for:

- mobility providers
- telecoms
- insurance
- relocation services
- coworking
- real estate



# Business Model

## Concierge Services

A human + AI assisted service for:

- tourists
- new residents
- property owners
- digital nomads



# Market Size

## Costa Blanca core numbers (conservative)

- 5M+ tourists / year
- 300k+ foreign residents
- ~1.5M total population
- ~50,000 local service & tourism businesses
- ~€15–20B annual tourism & local services economy

We monetise: discovery, bookings, services, attention, and data.



# Go to market Strategy

**We don't launch the app. We activate the whole region:**

## **Phase I:** Own One Town

- Onboard 200–500 businesses
- Add all services and attractions
- Partner with municipality

**Goal:** become “how things work” in that town.

## **Phase III:** Lock in institutions

Tourism boards, town halls, event organisers

**Goal:** become official distribution layer

## **Phase II:** Expand town–by–town

Each town adds: supply, demand, data, and network effect

## **Phase IV:** Scale the model

Once Costa Blanca works, clone it to Costa del Sol, Balearics...

## Revenue assumptions:

Average B2B Subscriptions: EUR 50 per month

# Competition

**Costera is not competing with apps. It is replacing fragmentation.**

**What exists today:**

Category	Examples	Why they fail?
Global marketplaces	Airbnb, Booking	Extract 20–30%, no local loyalty
Maps & search	Google Maps, TripAdvisor	Discovery only, no transactions
Social groups	Facebook, WhatsApp	Chaos, no trust, no monetisation
Local sites	Municipal websites	Static, siloed, no engagement

**Everyone owns a slice. No one owns region.**

# Competition: Costera moat

## Regional Network Effect

More businesses → better discovery → more users → more bookings → more businesses

## Municipal Integration

Costera becomes the event platform, info layer, and business directory. This makes it politically and structurally sticky.

## Data Advantage

Costera sees where people go, what they book, what's missing.

## Supply Lock—in

Local businesses get: bookings, reputation, CRM, repeat customers. Leaving Costera means losing their digital footprint.

## Platform, not app

Competitors are tools. Costera becomes infrastructure. Infrastructure wins.
